STATE & FEDERAL POLICY UPDATES

Virtual and in-person options now available! Kentucky Voices for Health and our coalition of ThriveKY partners host a monthly series of State & Federal policy updates, including quarterly forums held in collaboration with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services. We provide regular updates on the state of our economy, COVID-19 response, federal relief, and safety-net programs like Medicaid, SNAP, P-EBT, behavioral health, child care, and housing assistance. We also promote the importance of Open Enrollment, voter registration, and engagement in policy advocacy at the state and federal levels.
