In 2024, we had 100-300 individuals register for each of our virtual meetings and over 700 community professionals registered for our in-person statewide Advocacy for Thriving Community Roadshow series. In addition, we reach individuals by presenting at conferences for CHWs, social workers, FRYSCs, FQHCs, and other community professionals throughout the state.

We also promote all events and distribute recordings and materials to our mailing list of 2,400 health advocates. Our reach is steady and growing.

2025 THRIVEKY EVENTS

Kentucky Voices for Health and our coalition of ThriveKY partners will host 19 events in 2025, with at least one event each month.

Of the 11 virtual programs, 4 will be forums held in collaboration with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

There will be 8 in-person Roadshow stops from April to November throughout the state.

All programs will cover state and federal policy updates on our economy and safetynet programs like Medicaid, SNAP, Summer EBT, behavioral health, child care, transportation and housing assistance. We also promote the importance of Open Enrollment, voter registration, and engagement in policy advocacy at the state and federal levels.
